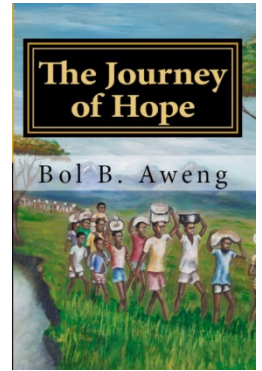


## LOST BOY OF SUDAN TELLS HIS STORY IN A NEW BOOK FOR CHILDREN

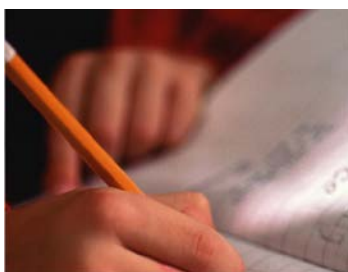


his journey of hope through his paintings with various churches, organization and to many school children. They have responded in raising the money needed to build a medical clinic in his village in South Sudan.
