The Lost Boys' Fun Run

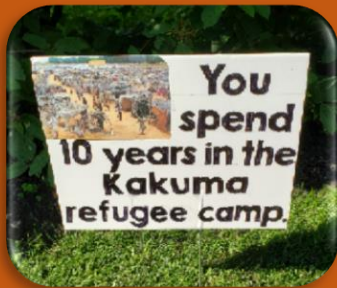

The Buckeye Clinic of South Sudan wishes to thank all who came, donated or sponsored children in South Sudan.



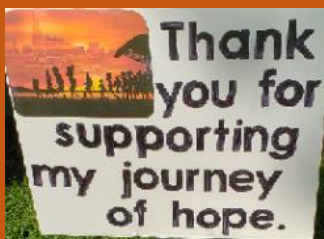
